Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with Austin Independent School District (AISD) for the City's contingent provision of public health services at AISD locations in the event of an emergency, beginning on September 30, 2026, with up to four one-year extension options. Funding: This item has no immediate fiscal impact. Should the interlocal agreement be activated, funding will be contingent upon emergency funds becoming available, and if available, the fiscal impact will be determined at that time.

Prior Council Action:

June 9, 2022 - Council approved the negotiation and execution of an interlocal agreement with Austin Independent School District (AISD) for the City's use of AISD's facilities and related services for the City to provide public health services to Austin/Austin County residents for a 19-month term beginning January 21, 2021, with four one-year renewal options, each in an amount not to exceed \$500,000. This item was approved on an 11-0 vote.

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Additional Backup Information:

This is a renewal of an interlocal agreement with AISD that was executed in July 2023 utilizing American Rescue Plan Act funding for emergency services. Approval of the negotiation and execution of this renewal will ensure continued preparedness for needed medical countermeasure activities such as vaccine administration, testing, and the provision of related services to the Austin/Travis County community.

Services provided by AISD will continue to include the use of temporary spaces, basic security services, basic custodial, janitorial, and trash removal services, cleaning of the temporary spaces before and after Austin Public Health events, and water, sanitary sewer, and electric utilities as necessary.
