## **RESOLUTION NO.**

WHEREAS, the City is eligible for \$14,040,638 in federal grant funds, including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA), and Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (collectively, the "Federal HUD Grants"); and

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WHEREAS, the City's proposed Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Community Development Program and annual Action Plan will use the Federal HUD Grants and local funding; and

WHEREAS, Council has, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(1), (2), and (3):

- identified in its Fiscal Year 2024-2029 Consolidated Plan, adopted on August 29, 2024, areas of the municipality in which predominantly low and moderate income persons reside, that are blighted or slum areas, or that are federally assisted new communities;
- 2. established in its Fiscal Year 2024-2029 Consolidated Plan, adopted on August 29, 2024, community development program areas in which community development activities, building rehabilitation, or the acquisition of privately owned buildings or land is proposed; and
- 3. adopted a Citizen Participation Plan (CCP) under which citizens may publicly comment on the proposed community development programs and the annual Action Plan (Resolution No. 19960328-031, as

amended by Resolution Nos. 20000113-029, 20040129-008, 20111215-089, and 20200521-014, and 20240718-065);

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Council conducted public hearings, on May 8, 2025, and June 5, 2025, to obtain public comment on the proposed Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 373.006(4) and Part 91, Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, the Community Development Commission conducted public hearings on April 8, 2025, and June 10, 2025, to obtain public comment on the proposed Action Plan and made its final recommendation on the proposed Action Plan on July 8, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City made the proposed Action Plan available for a public comment period beginning on May 26, 2025, and running through June 30, 2025; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Council approves the City's Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Action Plan and related Funding Table (attached to this Resolution and identified as **Exhibit "A"**).

## **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

Council authorizes the City Manager to submit, attest, execute, and deliver the necessary grant applications, certifications, and other related documents, including, but not limited to, applications, a final statement of community
