## UPCOMING HIGHLIGHTS

### Construction Continues on:

- Airport Blvd. – 55<sup>th</sup> St. to 45<sup>th</sup> St.
- Bike/Pedestrian improvements across corridors
- Signal and Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons across corridors
- William Cannon Drive – Running Water to McKinney Falls Pkwy (CAMPO grant)

### 2 projects going to bid in next 3 months

- Burnet Road – US 183 to Mopac (advertised as 2 segments)
- Slaughter Ln – Brodie to Mopac
- New IDIQ for bike/ped improvements – will be used for portions of Airport Blvd, Burnet Rd and N Lamar Blvd
