

### **M/WBE Summary**

Participation goals stated in the solicitation were **3.24%** African American; **3.25%** Hispanic; **2.89%** Asian/Native American; and **4.76%** WBE. The recommended firm provided an MBE/WBE Compliance that was compliant through Good Faith Efforts and was approved by the Small and Minority Business Resources Department. Total participation estimated on pre-construction phase services amount.

Public notice was given for this Request for Proposals CLMA056 New Mexic-Arte Museum, through the City's Austin Finance Online web portal. Two proposals were received and opened on April 2, 2025. Of the two submittals received, one was deemed non-responsive, and SpawGlass Contractors, Inc. was determined to be the best value, neither were certified MBE/WBE.
