

**RESOLUTION NO.**

**WHEREAS**, City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing in accordance with Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Chapter 26 to consider a resolution authorizing permanent and temporary changes in use of dedicated parkland, known as Adams-Hemphill Neighborhood Park, for Austin Watershed Protection to construct, use, and maintain two detention basins for stormwater control (Proposed Use); and

**WHEREAS**, Austin Watershed Protection requires approximately 138,136 square feet of parkland for permanent use and approximately 11,997 square feet for temporary use; and

**WHEREAS**, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibit A (Affected Land); and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the public hearing to be held on September 11, 2025, was given for three consecutive weeks on August 17, 24 and 31, 2025, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

**WHEREAS**, such public hearing was held on September 11, 2025, by City Council to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done

to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the  
Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
