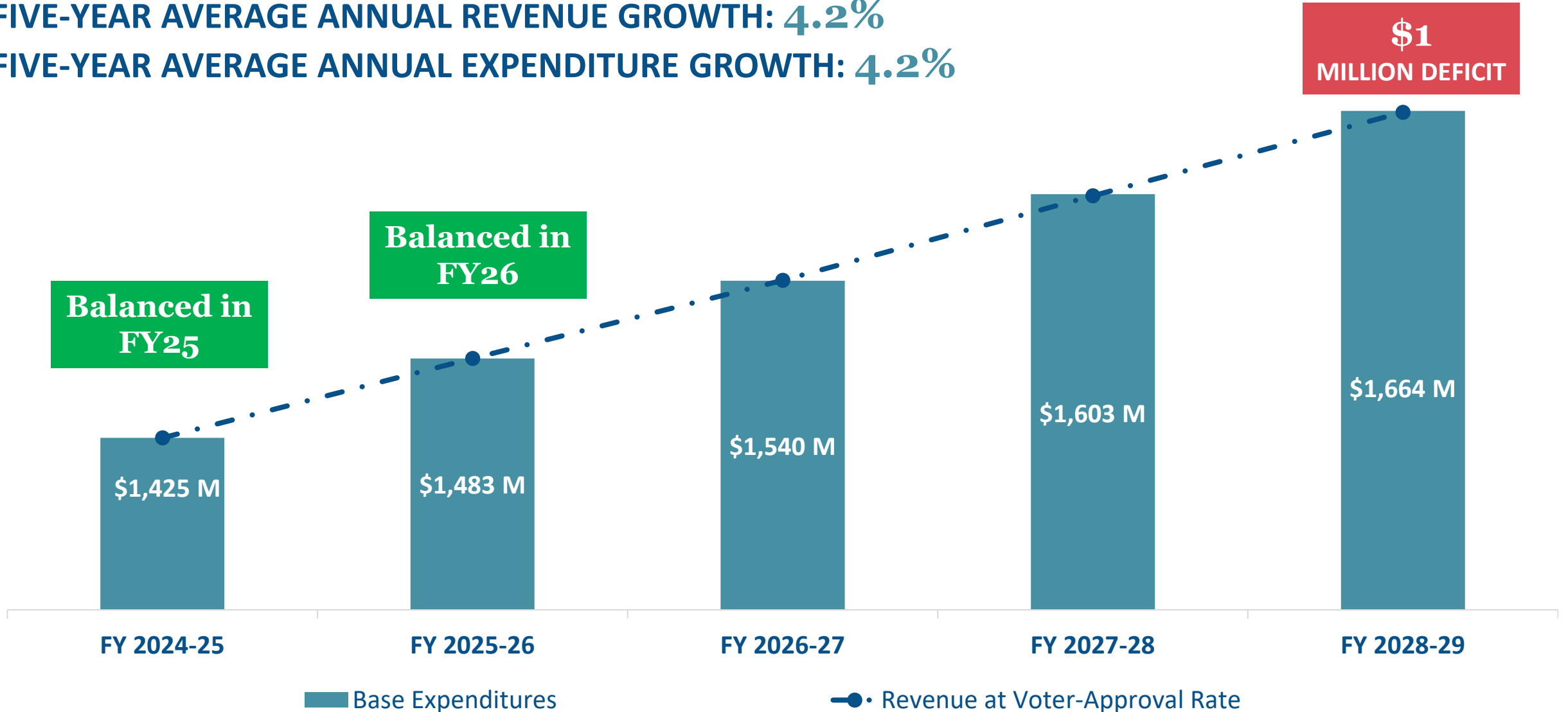

# FY25 APPROVED BUDGET: GF 5-Year Base Forecast

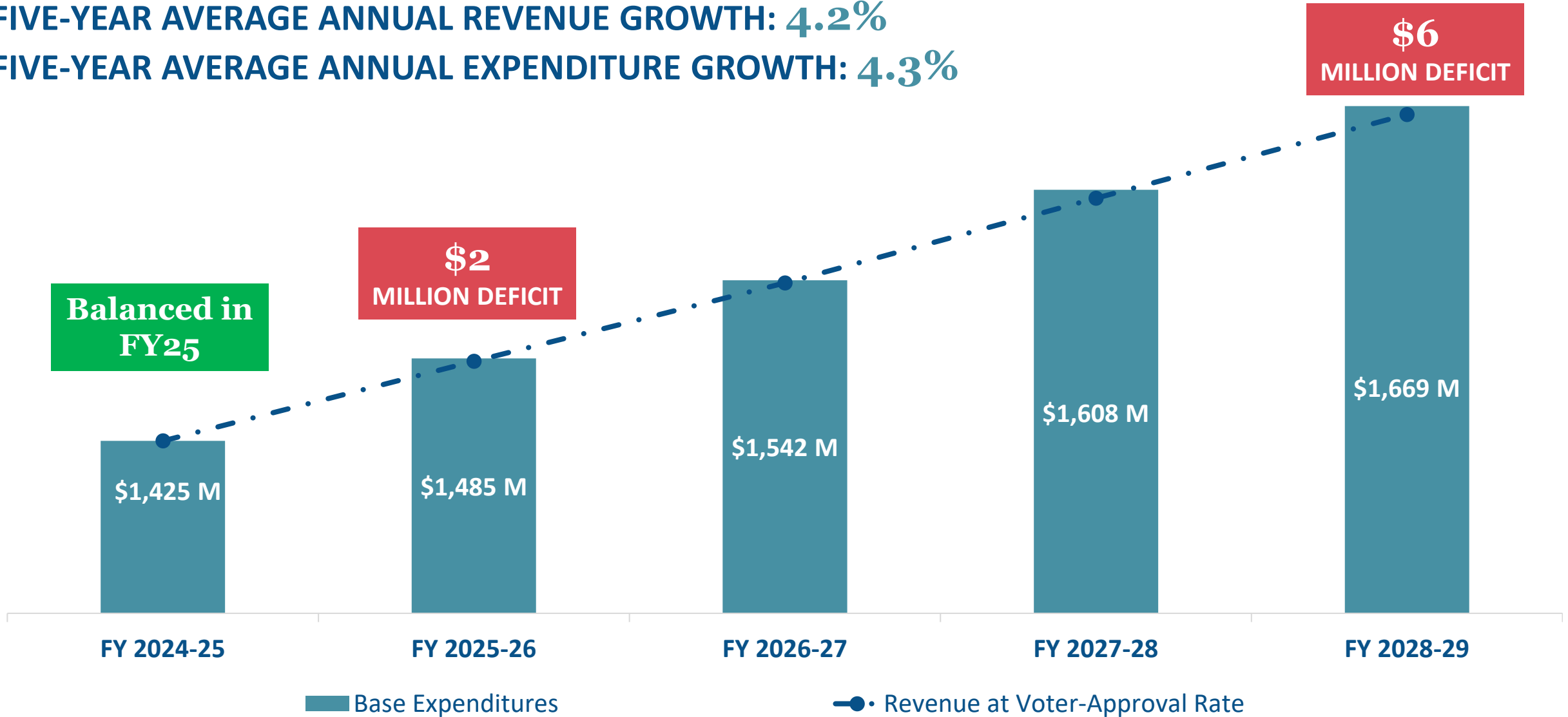
FIVE-YEAR AVERAGE ANNUAL REVENUE GROWTH: 4.2%

# APD Budget Remains Constant % of GF: 5-Year Forecast

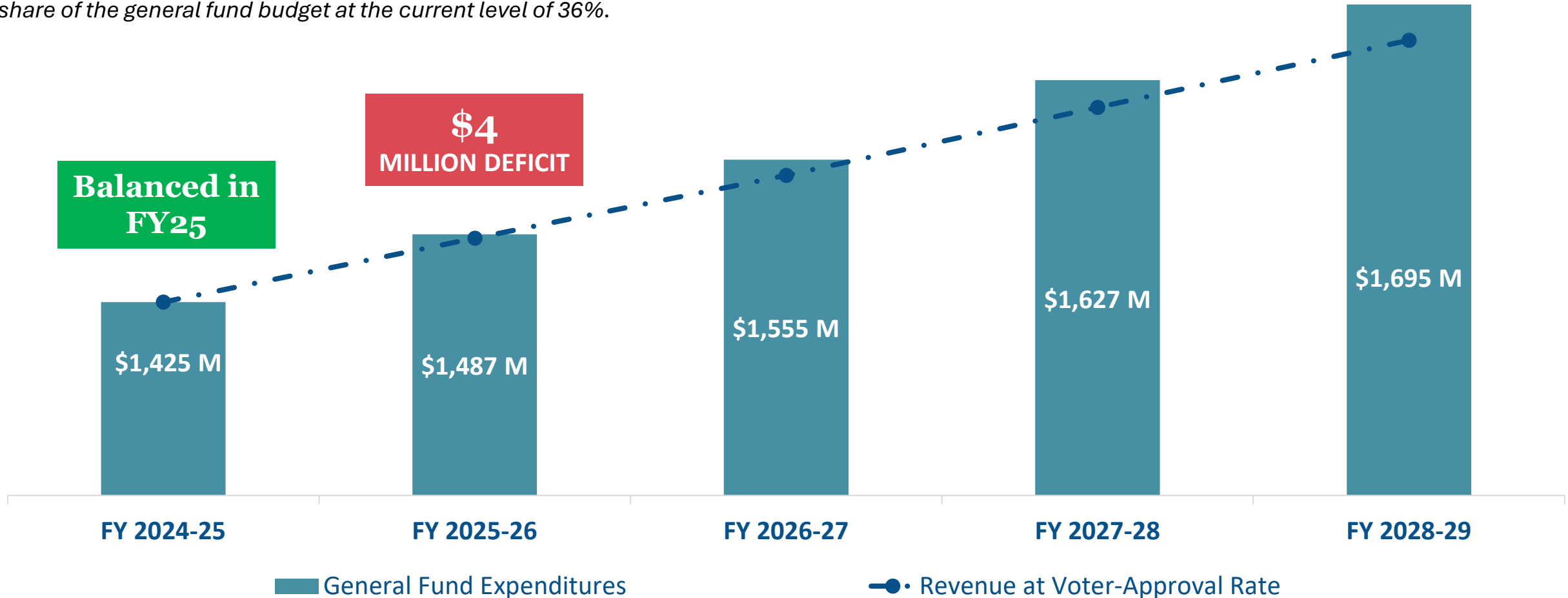

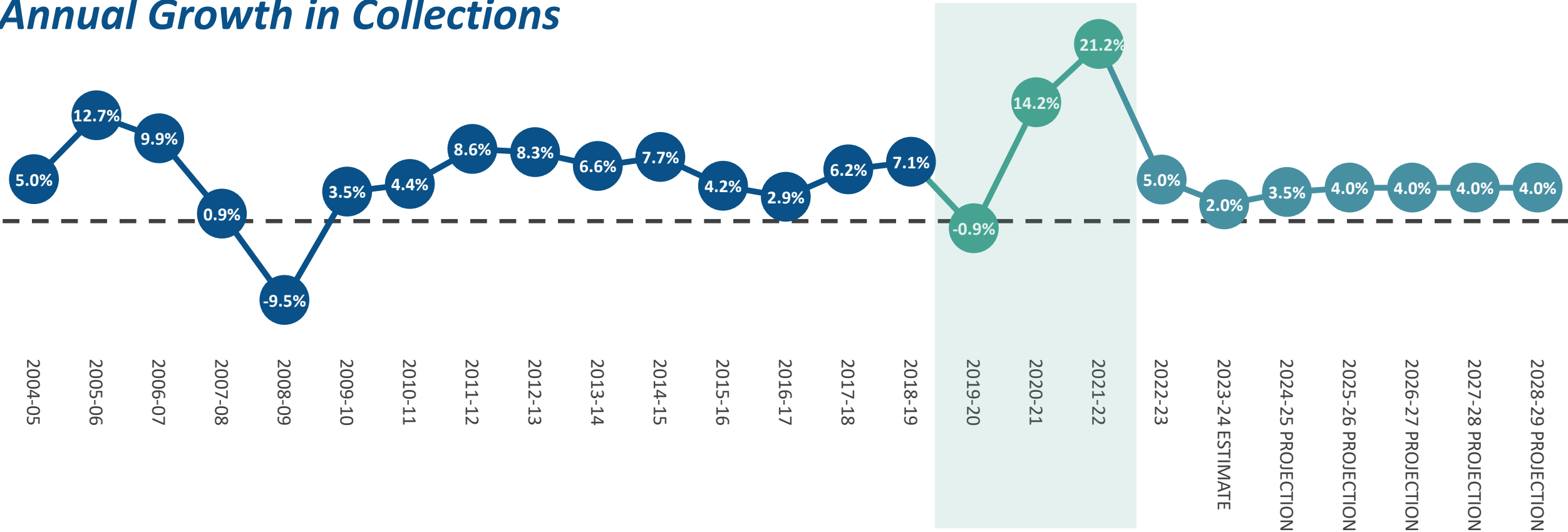

Pre-COVID 10-Year Average Annual Growth:

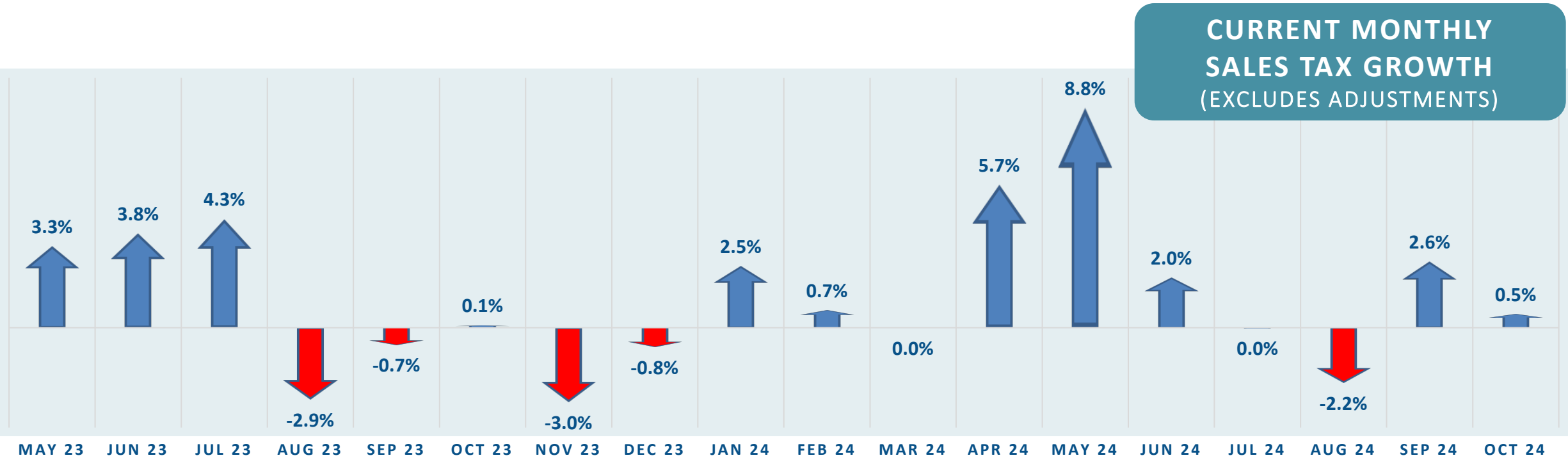

# Sales Tax Update

- Through 11 payments, FY24 year-to-date growth is 1.7%, \$0.2M below year-end estimate
- Current collections, which exclude adjustments, showing year-to-date growth of 1.8%
- 2.0% average monthly growth in current collections over trailing 6 months



## *\$11.4 Million in One-Time Funding for Contracts Appropriated from BSRF in FY25*

- \$3.2 million - Rapid Rehousing
- \$2.2 million - Homelessness Prevention services
- \$1.5 million - Expanded Mobile Crisis Outreach Team coverage
- \$1.3 million - Family Stabilization Grant program
- \$0.6 million - Parent Support Specialists
- \$0.4 million - reproductive health logistical support
- \$0.4 million - quality of life studies
- \$0.3 million - the Community Health Navigator program
- \$0.3 million - family homelessness services
- \$0.2 million - anti-hate education campaign
- \$0.2 million - community violence intervention programming
- \$0.2 million - cost-of-living adjustment for early childhood services contracts
- \$0.2 million - collective sex crimes response model support
- \$0.2 million - Planning community engagement efforts
- \$0.1 million - expansion of substance abuse Continuum of Care
- \$0.1 million - flood insurance premium subsidies
