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WHEREAS, in relation to the Project’s specifics and requirements, staff has considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures described in Chapter 252; and

WHEREAS, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to complete it, staff recommends use of the construction manager-at-risk method for buildings authorized by Subchapter F, Chapter 2269, Government Code as the project delivery method that provides the best value for the City; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Council finds that, with respect to expenditures necessary to design and construct a new Arrivals and Departures Hall at the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport, the construction manager-at-risk method described by Subchapter F of Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government Code provides the best value for the City.
