Additional Backup Information:

The City has the authority under state law to name public roads and assign address numbers within its city limits and has entered into an agreement with Travis County to coordinate updates to the 9-1-1 GIS database for the unincorporated parts of Travis County. This annual interlocal agreement between the City and CAPCOG, dating back to 2018, authorizes the City, under Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, to maintain and update the CAPCOG 9-1-1 GIS database during the period of October 1, 2024, through September 30, 2025, and to be compensated for such work.
