WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Transportation Code Chapter 1006 and Texas Administrative Code Title 43; Part 3; Chapter 57, entities are eligible to receive grants from the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority to provide financial support to law enforcement agencies for economic automobile theft enforcement teams and to combat motor vehicle burglary in the jurisdiction; and

The Assistant City Manager with responsibility for the Austin Police Department is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Motor Vehicle Crime Prevention Authority Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

The Austin Police Department Lieutenant for Property Crimes and Auto Theft is designated as the Project Director and the Austin Police Department Financial Manager is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
