


FY25 APPROVED BUDGET: GF 5-Year <u>Base</u> Forecast





FY25 APPROVED BUDGET w/ TA: GF 5-Year <u>Base</u>






APD Budget Remains Constant % of GF: 5-Year Forecast

Projected Tax Rate Increases to Balance 5-Year Forecast



Sales Tax Update



- Through 11 payments, FY24 year-to-date growth is 1.7%, \$0.2M below year-end estimate
- Current collections, which exclude adjustments, showing year-to-date growth of 1.8%
- 2.0% average monthly growth in current collections over trailing 6 months



FY25 One-Time Contract Funding



\$11.4 Million in One-Time Funding for Contracts Appropriated from BSRF in FY25

- \$3.2 million Rapid Rehousing
- \$2.2 million Homelessness Prevention services

- \$0.1 million expansion of substance abuse Continuum of Care

Creativity and Culture: A Celebration / Creatividad y Cultura: Una Celebración by Werllayne Nunes

Creativity and Culture: A Celebration, is a project of the Economic Development Department's Art in Public Places program. This four-paneled painting pays homage to the vibrant cultural arts of the African American community in East Austin – past and present, where the work is sited. It was created as part of the East Seventh Street Corridor streetscape, which includes a series of wayfinding obelisks (obeliscos) located at eight intersections.
