

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2023, Austin Firefighter (FF) Ian Miramon suffered severe, life-threatening injuries while in the line of duty, leaving him hospitalized for several months; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Act provides for up to a one-year leave of absence at full pay for firefighters who suffer illness or injury related to the firefighter's line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Act authorizes a municipality's governing body to extend a firefighter's leave of absence for a line of duty illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, FF Miramon began a leave of absence, at full pay, on June 17, 2023; and

WHEREAS, with Resolution No. 20240530-086, the Council extended FF Miramon's leave of absence at full pay through June 17, 2025; and

WHEREAS, FF Miramon is currently undergoing treatment for injuries and working extremely hard to rehabilitate; and

WHEREAS, FF Miramon intends to return to work when he is medically cleared; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The leave of absence for FF Miramon's June 17, 2023, line of duty related injury, authorized by Texas Local Government Code Section 143.073, is hereby extended, at full pay, until January 10, 2026. This extension shall be retroactive to June 18, 2025, and shall cover additional periods of leave necessitated by FF Miramon's injury.
