

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2025, a special municipal election was held to submit to the voters a proposed property (ad valorem) tax rate that exceeds the voter approval rate; voters were given the option of voting “for” or “against” the proposition; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the special election has been made to the Council and show that the votes for and against the proposition were cast as follows:

Proposition Q

For 62,952

Against 109,375

WHEREAS, a majority of all votes cast in the special election were cast against Proposition Q; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the special election as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the election; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the special election, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that Proposition Q is not adopted; and

With this canvass, Council is making official the precinct returns received from the counties.
