

- Austin Energy will ensure continuous access to the Festival Beach Community Garden and Festival Beach Food Forest throughout construction, with only short periods of restricted access at the Waller Street entrance for safety reasons; alternate access will remain available. (Attachment E).
- On-site trees may not be pruned over 25%, in accordance with City of Austin code. Austin Energy pruning will follow arborist guidelines and Austin Energy’s vegetation management standards to ensure public and system safety. Transmission structure placement has been designed to minimize impacts on critical root zones (see Austin Energy Vegetation Management).
- Austin Energy agrees to review the proposed plantings as outlined in the Parkland Donation Improvement, Maintenance, and Programming Agreement (Attachment F).
- Austin Energy will notify Austin Parks and Recreation upon completion of construction within parkland.

It is the responsibility of Austin Energy to initiate an IET funds transfer from AE FDU 3230 1107 K386 (SPID # 13180.017) to APR’s FDU 8741-8607-3020-4888 in the amount of (\$2,414,240) into within 30 Calendar Days after execution of this Memorandum of Understanding.
