ng its public hearing, the board or commission may postpone or inue an application's hearing to a later date or may evaluate the staff's recommendation and public input forwarding its own mmendation to the City Council. If the board or commission unces a specific date and time for a postponement or continuation is not later than 60 days from the announcement, no further notice quired.

ng its public hearing, the City Council may grant or deny a zoning est or rezone the land to a less intensive zoning than requested but case will it grant a more intensive zoning.

ever, in order to allow for mixed use development, the Council add the MIXED USE (MU) COMBINING DISTRICT to certain mercial districts. The MU Combining District simply allows lential uses in addition to those uses already allowed in the seven mercial zoning districts. As a result, the MU Combining District ws the combination of office, retail, commercial, and residential s within a single development.
