

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EXHIBIT A OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026
CITY OF AUSTIN FEES, FINES, AND OTHER CHARGES ORDINANCE
(ORDINANCE NO. 20250813-004) TO AMEND THE FEES FOR FOOD
ESTABLISHMENT PERMITS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Council finds the fee amounts adopted by this ordinance are necessary to protect public safety and maintain adequate food safety staffing levels.

PART 2. Council amends Exhibit A of the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 City of Austin Fees, Fines, and other Charges Ordinance (Ordinance No. 20250813-004) to amend the fees for food establishment permits, by amending the permit fee calculation method for each permit to use a risk based calculation method as follows, which is also shown in Attachment A:

Food Establishment Permits	Fee
Annual gross volume of food sales \$0 – \$49,999.99	\$309.00
Annual gross volume of food sales \$150,000 or more	\$927.00
Annual gross volume of food sales \$50,000 – \$149,999.99	\$618.00

For each permit, the permit fee is
the risk calculation method below for the applicable permit:

<u>1A - Low Risk/Large</u>	<u>\$515.00</u>
<u>1B - Low Risk/Medium</u>	<u>\$449.00</u>
<u>1C - Low Risk/Small</u>	<u>\$404.00</u>
<u>2A - Medium Risk/Large</u>	<u>\$845.00</u>
<u>2B - Medium Risk/Medium</u>	<u>\$713.00</u>
<u>2C - Medium Risk/Small</u>	<u>\$581.00</u>
<u>3A - High Risk/Large</u>	<u>\$927.00</u>
<u>3B - High Risk/Medium</u>	<u>\$900.00</u>
<u>3C - High Risk/Small</u>	<u>\$751.00</u>
