## **MOTION SHEET**

I move to approve with the following direction, which is in alignment with the Environmental Commission Recommendation 20250205-003:

City Council encourages the applicant to consider:

- 1. Incorporating solar panels into the development;
- 2. Providing at least 14 electric vehicle charging spaces upon opening and designing the development to provide at least 30 EV charging spaces total in the future;
- 3. Working with Patton Elementary and Small Middle Schools to offer signage or educational materials on the aquifer and watershed; and
- 4. Further reducing impervious cover from 45.29% to 40%.
- 5. Oversizing the water quality biofiltration pond to meet the minimum SOS pond capture depth standards;
- 6. Oversizing the water detention system to bring overall site outflow to greenfield conditions;
- 7. Further mitigating run-off, increase biodiversity, and reduce heat island effect by planting at least 100 trees and shrubs on-site; and
- 8. Including native pollinator species in the landscaping plan.

## City Council further directs City staff to explore:

- 1. Joint partnership opportunities with AISD to develop community parks that can serve this development on the Patton Elementary and Small Middle School campuses; and
- Updating the City's Roadway Capacity Plan to include roadway improvements on Westcreek Drive and Old Fredericksburg Road, with a focus on improvements that would also improve safety, to mitigate the impact of the new development.
