

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2024, a general municipal election was held for the purpose of electing the Mayor and City Council Members (single member districts) for District 2, District 4, District 6, District 7, and District 10; and on the same date a special election was held to present to the voters one proposition (Proposition P) regarding removing an area from the City’s extraterritorial jurisdiction, and voters were given the option of voting “for” or “against” the proposition; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the general election have been made to the Council and show that the votes for Mayor and City Council Members were cast as follows:

WHEREAS, Krista Laine received a majority of all votes cast for the office of City Council Member District 6; and

WHEREAS, of the two candidates who received the highest number of votes cast for the office of City Council Member District 7, those being Gary L. Bledsoe and Mike Siegel, neither candidate received a majority of all votes cast for City Council Member District 7; and

WHEREAS, Marc Duchon received a majority of all votes cast for the office of City Council Member District 10; and

WHEREAS, the returns of the special election have been made to the Council and show that the votes for and against Proposition P were cast as follows:

For 7

Against 3; and

WHEREAS, a majority of all votes cast in the special election were cast for Proposition P; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The Council finds that all of the recitals contained in this resolution are true and adopts them as findings of fact by this governing body; and

The Council finds that the results of the general election as tabulated and canvassed reflect the votes cast at the election; and

The Council accepts and approves the returns for the general election, as tabulated and received and canvassed, and declares that the following persons are
