

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the best interest of the residents of the City of Austin that the Legal Advocacy for Violent Crime Victims Project be operated for the project period of October 1, 2026 through September 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the City Council commits to provide any necessary matching funds for this grant through approval of the Austin Police Department budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Deputy City Manager as the authorized official with the power to apply for, accept, reject, agree to, alter, or terminate this grant on behalf of the Austin Police Department;

WHEREAS, the City Council designates the Chief Administrative Officer as the financial officer with the power to submit financial and/or programmatic reports or alter a grant on behalf of the Austin Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, the City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of the Governor in full; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council approves the submission of an application to, and acceptance of grant funds from, the Office of the Governor for the Legal Advocacy for Violent Crime Victims Project, designated as Grant Number 5379802 by the Office of the Governor.
