

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing in accordance with Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Chapter 26 to consider a resolution authorizing permanent and temporary changes in use of dedicated parkland, known as Williamson Creek Central and East Greenbelt, for Austin Water to construct and maintain approximately 18,800 linear feet of wastewater interceptor (Proposed Use); and

WHEREAS, Austin Water requires approximately 407,062 square feet of parkland for permanent use and approximately 388,725 square feet for temporary use; and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibit A (Affected Land); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on January 30, 2025, was given for three consecutive weeks on January 5, 12, and 19, 2025, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held on January 30, 2025, by City Council to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW,**

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done

to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
