ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The City utilized force account labor, materials, equipment, rented equipment, and contracts to help assist and aid with the threat of the storm. The FEMA Public Assistance grant awards will reimburse City departments for expenses incurred for carrying out Winter Storm Mara emergency response and repairs from January 30, 2023, to October 21, 2024. A City match of \$563,616 is required for the Winter Storm Mara award and was provided by the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Operating Budgets of various departments.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
