WHEREAS, the City seeks funding to implement safety improvements at high-crash intersections; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Transportation's (USDOT) Fiscal Year 2025 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) discretionary grant program awards funding on a competitive basis to support planning, infrastructure, behavioral, and operational initiatives to prevent death and serious injury on roads and streets involving all roadway users; and

WHEREAS, if obtained, the grant funds will be used to improve between four and six intersections that will achieve stated objectives called for in the SS4A grant program, including further promoting safety, employing low-cost, high-impact strategies that can improve safety at several intersections, ensuring investment in the safety needs of underserved communities, incorporating evidence-based projects and strategies, and aligning with additional priorities such as quality job creation and economic strength and global competitiveness; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager or designee is authorized to submit a grant application to the USDOT Fiscal Year 2025 SS4A discretionary grant program in an amount not to exceed \$8,000,000, and if awarded, a City match not to exceed \$2,000,000 for construction of between four and six major intersection safety projects.
