**Subject:** **2026 CAMPO Call for Projects – Update**

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update to the [December 11, 2025 memorandum](#) regarding the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) 2028–2031 Call for Projects.

### Candidate Projects

City staff have completed the screening process to identify projects that align with CAMPO's readiness requirements and scoring criteria, and are requesting Council approval during the January 22, 2026 Council meeting (Agenda Item #43) to submit the attached recommended candidate projects. Applications will be submitted before the deadline, January 30, 2026, by 5:00 p.m. (Central Time).

Candidate projects must have a local funding source to contribute to the required 20% local match and to cover up-front expenditures pending federal reimbursement. Local funding sources include, but are not limited to, approved bond funding, street impact fee revenue, certificates of obligation, or other sources if available. If awarded, City staff will return to Council to seek authorization to accept and appropriate federal funds and identify the funding source for the matching funds.

### Concurrence

Concurrence is required by an entity that has legal authority over any part of a project and could stop a project that is being developed by another entity. City staff are seeking TxDOT concurrence for all projects that are on or touch the State system. On January 13, 2026, Travis County Commissioners Court provided concurrence for the Pearce Lane application since part of the project is within the extraterritorial jurisdiction.

Additionally, Travis County is requesting concurrence from the City of Austin for their applications to develop plans for Decker Lake Road and Immanuel Road, which are partially within the city

limits. An item will be on the February 5, 2026 Council meeting agenda to provide concurrence for these applications. City staff support Travis County's applications and recommend approval
