RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City of Austin created the Austin Housing Finance Corporation (AHFC) in accordance with Chapter 394 of the Texas Local Government Code for the public purpose and function, among others, of providing a means to finance the cost of residential developments that will provide decent, safe, and sanitary housing at affordable prices for residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 22 of the Texas Business Organization Code (Code), authorizes the creation and organization of nonprofit corporations which may act as a duly constituted affiliate of a Texas housing finance corporation to aid and assist the housing finance corporation in the performance of one or more of its functions; and

WHEREAS, AHFC desires to further its public purposes and functions by creating an affiliated, nonprofit corporation and instrumentality named AHFC Cielo at North Domain Non-Profit Corporation (Nonprofit Corporation), appointing and maintaining its Board of Directors, and otherwise exercising control over the Nonprofit Corporation, its assets, and its dissolution; and

WHEREAS, AHFC is creating the Nonprofit Corporation to act as general partner, or controlling member of the general partner, of a Texas limited partnership (the Owner) that will own and operate a 64-unit multifamily rental development located at 9008 Galewood Drive, Austin, Texas 78758 (Development); and

**WHEREAS**, AHFC desires that the Nonprofit Corporation have and exercise all of the powers prescribed by the Code; and

**WHEREAS**, AHFC desires that the Nonprofit Corporation's Certificate of Formation and Bylaws be in the forms, and be executed, approved, and filed in the manner prescribed by this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the AHFC Board of Directors desires to authorize and approve the forms of the Certificate of Formation and Bylaws of the Nonprofit Corporation, appoint the Board of Directors and President of the Nonprofit Corporation, and take other action with respect to the Nonprofit Corporation; NOW, THEREFORE,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE AUSTIN HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION:

Section 1. The Board of Directors finds, determines, recites, and declares that it is wise, expedient, necessary, and advisable that the Nonprofit Corporation be formed. The Board of Directors approves the creation and organization of the Nonprofit Corporation under the provisions of the Code as a duly constituted affiliate, nonprofit corporation, and instrumentality of AHFC. The Board of Directors authorizes the Nonprofit Corporation to aid, assist, and act on its behalf and for the benefit of AHFC in the performance of its functions to acquire, develop, construct, and operate affordable housing in the City; to act as general partner, or controlling member of the general partner, of the Owner, which will own and operate the Development; to promote, develop, manage, maintain, and operate the Development, consistent with its role as general partner, or controlling member of the general partner, of the Owner, as decent, safe, and sanitary housing at affordable rental rates in a manner that achieves the public purpose and functions of AHFC; and to perform the other purposes described in the Nonprofit Corporation's Certificate of Formation.

**Section 2.** The Board of Directors authorizes the Nonprofit Corporation to enter into a ground lease for the Development and to assign the ground lease as necessary.

**Section 3**. The Board of Directors approves the Certificate of Formation of the Nonprofit Corporation in substantially the form attached as **Exhibit A** and authorizes the incorporator of the Nonprofit Corporation to file such Certificate of Formation with the Texas Secretary of State in the manner provided by law.

**Section 4.** The Board of Directors appoints the initial board of directors of the Nonprofit Corporation, with their terms of office to expire at the time indicated.

Veronica Briseño is appointed as the President of the Nonprofit Corporation. Other officers will be appointed as provided in the Bylaws of the Nonprofit Corporation.

**Section 5.** The Board of Directors approves the Bylaws of the Nonprofit Corporation in substantially the form attached as **Exhibit B** and authorizes the President of the Nonprofit Corporation to execute and file them in the corporate records in the manner provided by law.

**Section 6.** The Board of Directors finds, determines, recites, and declares that no note, bond, loan, debt, or other obligation of the Nonprofit Corporation is an indebtedness, liability, general or moral obligation, or pledge of the faith or credit of the State of Texas, the City, AHFC, or any other political subdivision or governmental unit, nor shall any such note, bond, loan, debt, or other obligation constitute an indebtedness within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory

debt limitation or restriction or an agreement, obligation, or indebtedness of AHFC, the City, or the State of Texas within the meaning of AHFC's Articles of Incorporation, the City Charter, or of any constitutional or statutory provision whatsoever.

Section 7. The Board of Directors finds, determines, recites, and declares that it is the purpose, intent, and desire of AHFC in approving the creation of the Nonprofit Corporation and the forms of its Certificate of Formation and Bylaws that such actions and the Nonprofit Corporation hereby authorized comply with the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the Treasury Regulations and Internal Revenue Service rulings promulgated thereunder and the rulings issued pursuant thereto, such that the Nonprofit Corporation is determined to be a constituted nonprofit corporation acting as an asset of AHFC pursuant to the provisions of the Code and Chapter 394 of the Texas Local Government Code.

**Section 8.** This Resolution takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Board of Directors.
