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I think my most important general qualifications are: (1) I will take the responsibility seriously and show up regularly, working between meetings to ensure results; (2) I will work hard to master the subject-matter issues that are presented; (3) I have good critical-thinking skills and often help others see things from different perspectives, (4) I play well with others in volunteer (and professional) settings, (5) I work diligently to understand the views of others and build decisional consensus; and (6) I enjoy policy work and the challenges it presents. Professionally, I am an attorney and have worked successfully with government entities on a regular basis. I typically represent individual whistleblowers, many of whom have related employment claims resulting from retaliation. That experience is directly related to work reviewing employee appeals brought before the Municipal Civil Service Commission and provides me balance of having seen both sides of the employment relationship. I have also served on many volunteer boards and understand how to improve their effectiveness. I am also particularly interested in possibly serving on the Public Safety and Electric Utility Commissions, where I believe I can add value as an outstanding lay, community member. As to the Public Safety Commission, I learned much from working with the TMO Police Reform Action Team in the wake of George Floyd's death, working with law enforcement officials to discover mutually beneficial solutions for citizens. As an Austin homeowner, I invited the AFD to use my to-be-demolished home as a training facility and further engaged with AFD personnel to understand firefighting tactics and strategies in distant neighborhoods. Regarding the Electric Utility Commission, we, as a society, are at a generational crossroad regarding electric power generation and reliability with a plethora of opportunities being presented for alternative fuel sources and microgrid operation. I have done significant reading on this subject and feel qualified to learn the details needed to guide future policy.

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## **Texas Open Records Act**

**City of Austin Officials are able to choose whether or not their home address, home telephone numbers, emergency contact information, social security number, and information that reveals whether they have family members are available to the public on request. The Texas Public Information Act is a State law that requires the City of Austin to disclose this information to anyone who requests it. The only exceptions are for: 1) commissioned peace officers; and 2) Official who file a written request to withhold this information.
