Authorize negotiation and execution of an amendment to the agreement with Austin Travis County Mental Health & Mental Retardation Center d/b/a Integral Care aka Austin Travis County Integral Care to provide housing services for people living with HIV for a 12-month term, ending on September 30, 2025, to add one-time funding in an amount not to exceed \$23,153, for a revised total agreement amount not to exceed \$717,668. Funding: \$158,481 is available in the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Austin Public Health Department Special Revenue Budget. Funding for remaining years of the agreement is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Prior Council Action:

December 8, 2022- Council authorized resolution 20221208-43 for the negotiation and execution of agreements with four social service agencies to provide HIV-related housing services for an initial 12-month term beginning October 1, 2022, in a combined amount not to exceed \$2,287,955, each with four 12-month extension options in a combined amount not to exceed \$11,439,775, for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$13,727,730 divided among the agencies. The motion authorizing the negotiation and execution of agreements with four social service agencies on an 11-0 vote.

This action will authorize the negotiation and execution of Amendment No. 3 with Austin Travis County Mental Health & Mental Retardation Center d/b/a Integral Care also known as Austin Travis County Integral Care to provide housing services to people living with HIV.

The agreement was renewed from 2024 to 2025, including Amendments Nos. 1 and 2. Amendment 2 was a no -cost amendment to reallocate funds from the Permanent Housing Program to Short-Term Supportive Housing, and from Short-Term Rental, Mortgage, and Utilities to Short-Term Supportive Housing.

The current social services agreement with Integral Care was awarded as a result of Austin Public Health Department's Health Equity Request for Applications. Services began on October 1, 2022, for an initial 12-month term ending on September 30, 2023, in the amount of \$135,328, with four 12-month extension options for a total agreement amount not to exceed \$694,515.
