## **RESOLUTION NO.** 1 2 WHEREAS, on July 20, 2023, Council approved Ordinance No. 20230720-190 (Ordinance) establishing the police reserve force in line with Texas Local 3 Government Code Section 341.012; and 4 5 **WHEREAS**, the police chief has appointed the individuals named below to the police reserve force; and 6 WHEREAS, the appointed members are licensed peace officers and meet 7 the qualifications and standards established by the Texas Commission on Law 8 Enforcement and required by the Ordinance; and 9 WHEREAS, Council must approve the appointments in order that the 10 11 reserve officers have the authority to carry a weapon or otherwise act as a peace officers; and 12 WHEREAS, the total size of the police reserve force may not exceed 75 13 members; and 14 WHEREAS, the police chief may call members into service at any time the 15 police chief considers it necessary to have additional officers to preserve the peace 16 and enforce the law; and 17 WHEREAS, reserve police officers may, however, act only in a 18 19 supplementary capacity to the regular police force and may not assume the fulltime duties of regular police officers; and 20 **WHEREAS**, members of the reserve police force are temporary employees 21 and serve at the discretion of the police chief; and 22

23	WHEREAS, the licensed peace officers appointed by Robin J. Henderson,
24	Interim Chief of Police, are William Johns, Kurt Bailey, Charles Riley, Michael
25	Barker, and William Nelson; and

WHEREAS, the persons appointed by the Interim Chief of Police meet the
prerequisites established by the Ordinance for appointment to the police reserve
force; NOW, THEREFORE,
