Ratify a contract for automotive after-market and custom air conditioning parts for Austin Fleet Mobility Services with Austin Rebuilders AC Parts and Hoses, Inc., in the amount of \$12,364.00 for a contract amount not to exceed \$88,364.00. Funding: \$12,364.00 was available for the portion of the contract being ratified in the Operating Budget of Austin Fleet Mobility Services.

### **Additional Backup Information:**

The contract has provided automotive after-market and custom air conditioning parts to support the department's vehicle maintenance operations.

The contract was awarded administratively, with administrative spend in FY25 and FY26, but FY25 spend exceeded the City Manager's Authority limit and now requires ratification. The department is implementing improved internal controls to manage contract spending and ensure compliance going forward.

The additional authority allowed Austin Fleet Mobility Services to respond to the unexpected influx of demand for air conditioning maintenance services to support Austin Emergency Medical Services, Austin Fire, and Austin Resource Recovery vehicles.
