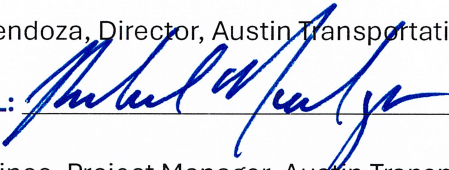

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A right-of-way vacation application has been received to vacate approximately a 232,205 square foot tract of land in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, being the paved/developed Right-of-way being a tract of land containing 5.3307 acres (232,205 square feet) out of the Santiago del Valle Grant, Abstract No. 24, Travis County, Texas, being all of Edwin Lane (variable width right-of-way; no record information found) . The applicant states the following, in the transmittal letter, when asked how they plan to develop the area to be vacated:

*Advanced Manufacturing.*

The abutting property owner, Dogs Head Land JV, LTD is seeking the Right-of-way Vacation.

Attached are the application packet and the Master Comment Report. All affected departments and private utility franchise stakeholders have reviewed the request and recommended approval, subject to the conditions in the Master Comment Report.

Public Notifications will be sent on **June 10, 2026**, to all adjacent property owners within 300 feet of the right-of-way vacation area. To date, **public objections have not been received.**

Following the approval from the Austin Transportation and Public Works Director, the right-of-way vacation application will be scheduled for the following Boards and Commissions Agendas.
