WHEREAS, the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) administers the State Water Implementation Fund for Texas (SWIFT) low-interest loan program established by the Texas Legislature in 2013; and

WHEREAS, Austin Water's waterline services replacement program was established to systematically replace water service lines (the small-diameter lines that connect water mains to customer meters) in order to reduce water loss throughout Austin's distribution system; and

WHEREAS, polybutylene pipes tend to fail at a disproportionately high rate compared to other materials, such as copper and high-density polyethylene (HDPE); and

WHEREAS, since 2001, Austin Water has been proactively replacing polybutylene and polyethylene services in areas of high static pressure using both internal forces and contractor resources in multiple phases; and

WHEREAS, Austin Water is seeking a low interest loan, not to exceed \$45,000,000 from the TWDB Board to fund an additional phase, which will replace another 6,000 polybutylene service lines across multiple Council districts; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager to file an application with the Texas Water Development Board for a low-interest loan from the SWIFT loan program in an amount not to exceed \$45,000,000 to provide for Austin Water's polybutylene pipe replacement project (also known as the Municipal Conservation Project).
