Public Awareness

Develop an enhanced informational webpage

- Preparation steps before the permit process
- Added interdepartmental resources for the moving process
- All required documents available in centralized location
- Seven residential relocation options with in-depth instructions



Public Awareness

Development Tracker

- Search all active demolitions and relocations in the city
- View a structure's age for a proposed demolition
- Filter by Council districts

Application Changes

- Updated relocation application to detail submittal requirements
- Added Development Tracker link
- Demolition application includes relocation information as alternate path





Process

Prioritizing House Relocations

- DSD will assign priority to Relocation applications for faster processing
- Adhere to timeline of 3-5 business days for Relocation; timeline may be longer depending on relocation scenario
