## PUBLIC HEARING INFORMATION

Although applicants and/or their agent(s) are expected to attend a public hearing, you are not required to attend or participate. However, if you participate, you have the opportunity to speak FOR or AGAINST the proposed development or change if you register in advance. You may also contact a neighborhood or environmental organization that has expressed an interest in an application affecting your neighborhood. To participate at this Public Hearing, you may either attend virtually by viewing the meeting online and registering to speak in advance or by going to City Hall at 301 West 2nd Street and attending in-person. During a public hearing; the City Council may postpone or continue an applications hearing to a later date, or recommend approval or denial of the application. If the City Council announces a specific date and time for a postponement or continuation that is not later than 60 days from the announcement, no further notice is required.

An interested party is defined as a person who is the applicant or record owner of the subject property, or who communicates an interest to a board or commission by:

- delivering a written statement to the board or commission before or during the public hearing that generally identifies the issues of concern (it may be delivered to the contact listed on a notice); or
- appearing and speaking for the record at the public hearing; and:
- is the record owner of property within 300 feet of the subject property or proposed development; or
- is an officer of an environmental or neighborhood organization that has an interest in or whose declared boundaries are within 300 feet of the subject property or proposed development.

Written comments must be submitted to the board or commission (or the contact person listed on the notice) before or at a public hearing. Your comments should include the name of the board or commission, or Council; the scheduled date of the public hearing; the Case Number; and the contact person listed on the notice.
