

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2025, Mayor Kirk Watson, acting in accordance with authority granted to him under the Charter and under Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code, declared a local state of disaster for the City due to severe drought and fire weather conditions creating widespread and significant wildfire danger posing an imminent threat to persons and property (the “Disaster Declaration”); and

WHEREAS, Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that such a declaration of disaster may not be continued for a period of more than seven days except with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the City is taking extraordinary measures to protect residents and property from the threat of wildfires; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the disaster declaration will continue to exist for a period of more than seven days; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the Disaster Declaration signed by the Mayor, and consents to its continuation for a period of more than seven days; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council hereby extends the Disaster Declaration signed by Mayor

Kirk Watson on October 20, 2025, and consents to its continuation from the date the Disaster Declaration was signed through December 11, 2025, or until such time as it is terminated by action of the Council, whichever is sooner.
