

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, by memorandum dated April 24, 2026, the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration allocated \$5,500,000 for a Community Project Funding/Congressionally Directed Spending Earmark for design and construction of the initial phase of the West Bouldin Creek Trail from Barton Springs Road to 6th Street and the Connecting Windsor Park: Belfast Bridge & Trail from Broadmoor Drive to East 51st Street; and

WHEREAS, this funding accounts for 80% of the estimated total design and construction amount; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to match 20% of the estimated total design and construction amount, plus any cost overruns, and is also responsible for funding the non-design and non-construction aspects of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to authorize the negotiation and execution of an Advance Funding Agreement with TxDOT for the above-described scopes of work; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager or designee, or the Assistant City Manager, is authorized to negotiate and execute an advance funding agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for Phase 1 of the West Bouldin Creek Trail and for the Connecting Windsor Park: Belfast Bridge and Trail projects, for a total estimated project cost of \$7,237,691 plus any costs overruns.
