

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

27 The terms of the ILA should be developed in partnership with Travis County
28 to determine:

- 29 • the appropriate event size threshold for coordinated City/County efforts;
- 30 • the appropriate proximity to City limits threshold for coordinated
31 City/County efforts; and
- 32 • any other threshold criteria for coordinated City/County efforts.

33 The scope of the ILA should include, but not be limited to:

- 34 • addressing regulatory gaps between the City and County, to the extent
35 legally permissible and logistically feasible;
- 36 • coordination of public safety and emergency response planning;
- 37 • coordination of transportation planning, such as parking, road closures,
38 transportation services planning, and traffic detours;
- 39 • ensuring the availability of information about planned special events, both
40 internally and to the public, including making information available through
41 311, as well as appropriate signage and notification about the event; and
- 42 • opportunities for potential coordination and outreach to neighboring
43 residents in the City and Travis County who may be impacted by the
44 planned special event.

46 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:**

47 The City Manager is directed to report to Council by May 31, 2026, with an
48 update on the status of a draft interlocal agreement.
