2	WHEREAS, the City of Austin (City) created the Austin Housing Finance
3	Corporation (AHFC) in accordance with Chapter 394 of the Local Government
4	Code for the public purpose and function, among others, of providing a means to
5	finance the cost of residential developments that will provide decent, safe, and
6	sanitary housing at affordable prices for residents of the City of Austin; and
7	WHEREAS, Chapter 22 of the Texas Business Organization Code (Code),
8	authorizes the creation and organization of nonprofit corporations which may act
9	as a duly constituted affiliate of a Texas housing finance corporation to aid and
10	assist the housing finance corporation in the performance of one or more of its
11	functions; and
12	WHEREAS, AHFC furthered its public purposes and functions by creating
13	an affiliated, nonprofit corporation and instrumentality named AHFC Drowsy
14	Willow Non-Profit Corporation (Nonprofit Corporation), appointing and
15	maintaining its Board of Directors, and otherwise exercising control over the
16	Nonprofit Corporation, its assets, and its dissolution; and
17	WHEREAS, AHFC authorized the creation of the Nonprofit Corporation
18	under Resolution Number 20240718-AHFC005 to acquire, construct, develop,
19	finance, manage, and sell approximately 42 affordable, ownership units as part of a
20	Community Land Trust (CLT) located at or near 5901 Drowsy Willow Trail,
21	Austin, Texas 78744 (Development); and
22	WHEREAS, AHFC desires that the Nonprofit Corporation's Certificate of
23	Formation and Bylaws be amended to allow the Nonprofit Corporation (i) to serve
24	as the managing member of a limited liability company, or the general partner of a
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limited partnership, (collectively the Owner), that will construct, develop, finance, 26 manage, and sell approximately 38 affordable, ownership units in the 27 Development, and (ii) to serve as the general contractor for the construction of the 28 29 Development; and 30 **WHEREAS**, it is expected that the Owner will create a condominium 31 regime that will manage the common and limited common elements of the CLT; 32 and WHEREAS, it is expected that AHFC, or an affiliated entity, will ground 33 lease the land for the Development to the Owner under the terms of a ground lease, 34 35 which will be assigned to the condominium regime; and 36 **WHEREAS**, AHFC desires that the Nonprofit Corporation have and 37 exercise all of the powers prescribed by the Code; and **WHEREAS**, the AHFC Board of Directors desires to authorize and approve 38 the forms of the Certificate of Amendment and Amended and Restated Bylaws of 39 40 the Nonprofit Corporation and take other action with respect to the Nonprofit Corporation; NOW, THEREFORE, 41 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE 42 **AUSTIN HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION:** 43 **Section 1.** The AHFC Board of Directors finds, determines, recites, and 44 declares that it is wise, expedient, necessary, and advisable that the Nonprofit 45 Corporation's Certificate of Formation and Bylaws be amended as stated in the 46

- 58 public purpose and functions of AHFC; and to perform the other purposes
- 59 described in the Nonprofit Corporation's Certificate of Formation.
- Section 2. The AHFC Board of Directors approves the Certificate of
- Amendment of the Nonprofit Corporation in substantially the form attached as
- 62 **Exhibit A** and authorizes the Officers of the Nonprofit Corporation to file such
- 63 Certificate of Formation with the Secretary of State of the State of Texas in the
- 64 manner provided by law.
- Section 3. The Board of Directors reappoints the initial board of directors of
- 66 the Nonprofit Corporation, with their terms of office to expire at the time indicated.

- Veronica Briseño is appointed as the President of the Nonprofit Corporation.
- 72 Other officers will be appointed as provided in the Amended and Restated Bylaws.
- Section 4. The AHFC Board of Directors approves the Amended and
- 74 Restated Bylaws of the Nonprofit Corporation in substantially the form attached as
- 75 **Exhibit B** and authorizes the President of the Nonprofit Corporation to execute
- and file them in the corporate records in the manner provided by law.

Section 5. The AHFC Board of Directors authorizes a ground lease with the Owner, which will be assigned to the condominium association that will manage the common and limited common elements of the CLT.

Section 6. The AHFC Board of Directors finds, determines, recites, and declares that no note, bond, loan, debt, or other obligation of the Nonprofit Corporation is an indebtedness, liability, general or moral obligation, or pledge of the faith or credit of the State of Texas, the City of Austin, AHFC, or any other political subdivision or governmental unit. In addition, no note, bond, loan, debt, or other obligation constitutes an indebtedness within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory debt limitation or restriction or an agreement, obligation, or indebtedness of AHFC, the City of Austin, the State of Texas within the meaning of AHFC's Articles of Incorporation, the City of Austin's City Charter, or of any constitutional or statutory provision whatsoever.

Section 7. The AHFC Board of Directors finds, determines, recites, and declares that it is the purpose, intent, and desire of AHFC in approving the creation of the Nonprofit Corporation and the forms of its Certificate of Amendment and Amended and Restated Bylaws, that such actions and the Nonprofit Corporation hereby authorized comply with the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the Treasury Regulations and Internal Revenue Service rulings promulgated thereunder and the rulings issued pursuant thereto, such that the Nonprofit Corporation is determined to be a constituted nonprofit corporation acting as an asset of AHFC pursuant to the provisions of the Code and Chapter 394 of the Texas Local Government Code.

Section 8. This Resolution takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Board of Directors.
