

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing in accordance with Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Chapter 26 to consider a resolution authorizing a permanent change in use of approximately 31,694 square feet of dedicated parkland located in Balcones District Park for Austin Water to construct, operate, maintain, and repair an odor and corrosion control facility for the Little Walnut Creek and Walnut Creek wastewater interceptors (Proposed Use); and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibit A (Affected Land); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on August 28, 2025, was given for three consecutive weeks on August 3, 10, and 17, 2025, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, City Council held such public hearing on August 28, 2025, to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been done to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
