## BACKGROUND

TRANSPORTATION PUBLIC WORKS

- Council resolution for increased bike lane enforcement led to Council approval of parking code modernization for 12-3 & 12-5
  - Included update to 12-5-56 for the possibility to mail parkingrelated citations. Staff committed to come to July Mobility Committee with an update.



### BACKGROUND

## TRANSPORTATION PUBLIC WORKS

#### Data on bike lane enforcement

- 270 warnings issued from March through May
- 80 citations provided in June
- 516 bike-lane enforcement resident requests (March through June)

Residential Parking Program (RPP) survey and Proposed Director Rules



# CONTINUED PARKING ENFORCEMENT CHALLENGES



- Significant increase in demand for curb space and new mobility alternatives
- Increasing number of managed parking areas and expanded geographic coverage with bike lane enforcement
- Hazards for public travel and confrontations with enforcement staff
- Misalignment between traditional parking enforcement strategies and modernized code
- Compliance issues with parking regulations

### POTENTIAL BENEFITS OF MAILING PARKING CITATIONS

- Increase accountability, safety, and efficiency in parking enforcement
- Limit blockage of travel lanes, maintaining transportation system efficiency
- Conflict reduction between the public and enforcement officers
- Compliance and capacity
- Enforcement consistency





### **IMPLEMENTATION CONSIDERATIONS**

## TRANSPORTATION PUBLIC WORKS

#### **Steps in Mailing Citations**

- Identify and verify the violation and vehicle information
- Identify registered owner
- Mail the citation

#### **Municipal Court System Integration**

- Municipal Court is still implementing phase 1 of their new court software, and it is not configured for staff to mail out parking citations
- Mailing notices will require third-party integration with the court software

#### **Third Party Vendor Options**

- Parking-specific enforcement technology available, can be customized
  - Examples from other cities
- Honor the direction included within prior Council Resolutions (20220915-056 and 20230608-085) related to technology use and data collection and retention, access

### **PROPOSED NEXT STEPS**



#### **Continued collaboration with Municipal Court**

- Define desired processes and outcomes
- Determine preferred implementation approach
- Develop procedures to ensure compliance with parking codes

#### Finalize scope and metrics of a potential pilot

- Define desired features and operational parameters, data requirements
- Establish measurable, reproduceable metrics to evaluate the pilot

#### **Procurement process for third-party vendor**

- Identify the right approach to efficiently onboard a vendor
- Research vendors and evaluate products and integration capabilities

#### Bring back to Council for review and approval
