Approve an ordinance amending City Code Chapter 11-2 to require short-term rental platforms to collect and remit hotel occupancy taxes (HOT) and to provide certain information if the platform collects payments on behalf of STR owners and to require short-term rental owners to provide HOT-related documentation. Additional Backup Information:

If approved, this ordinance will add provisions to City Code Chapter 11-2 (Hotel Occupancy Tax) to require STR platforms to collect and remit Hotel Occupancy Tax (HOT) on behalf of their users. The ordinance would also require STR owners/operators to provide the City with documentation that shows how much HOT was remitted on their behalf by a STR platform.

Currently, individual STR owners are required to collect and remit HOT on a quarterly basis.
