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26 **WHEREAS**, in relation to the Project’s specifics and requirements, staff has
27 considered the methods described in Chapter 2269 and reviewed the procedures
28 described in Chapter 252; and

29 **WHEREAS**, with respect to the Project and the expenditures necessary to
30 complete it, staff recommends use of the construction manager-at-risk method for
31 buildings authorized by Subchapter F, Chapter 2269, Government Code as the
32 project delivery method that provides the best value for the City; **NOW,**
33 **THEREFORE,**

34 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

35 The City Council finds that with respect to expenditures necessary for the
36 expansion and enhancement of the critical utility systems of the Austin-Bergstrom
37 International Airport through the Utility Infrastructure project as a part of the
38 Airport Expansion and Development Program, the construction manager-at-risk
39 method described by Subchapter F of Chapter 2269 of the Texas Government
40 Code provides the best value for the City.
