


Mission

Staffing/Operations for Operation Blue Santa (OBS)

Operations location of Blue Santa and is not easily accessible, centralized or welcoming to the community.

The space does not allow for community gatherings and engagement opportunities for all age groups.

Professional staff perform warehouse tasks (forklift operation, boxing, packaging, inventory) associated with the OBS program.

This is in addition to the coordination of the program as liaisons.

Due to continued staffing challenges, sworn teammates are not always available for Community Engagement opportunities.

Austin community members want Officers to be present at more events.

Operation Blue Santa



- Provides gifts to families in need in the City of Austin during the holiday season. More than 5,000 families served annually.
- About 14,000 children benefitted from Operation Blue Santa.
- Approximately 60,000 toys.

National Night Out




- Multi-agency partnership.

- Over 400 parties held throughout the Central Texas area each year.


