WHEREAS, the City has initiated and completed several analyses to identify City service needs; and

WHEREAS, it is vital that the City allocate and prioritize potential funding that will address issues such as transportation infrastructure, parks, libraries, museums and cultural arts facilities, animal shelter, and a homeless resource center and shelter; and

WHEREAS, Council approved Resolution No. 20240829-138 establishing a Bond Election Advisory Task Force (BEATF) to evaluate and recommend potential capital projects for a bond election; and

WHEREAS, the BEATF concluded its work on May 4, 2026, with a vote adopting their proposed bond recommendations and subsequently issued its 2026 Bond Election Advisory Task Force Recommendation Report on May 15, 2026; and

WHEREAS, City staff proposed recommended changes to the proposed BEATF recommendations and reported such revisions in a memo to the Mayor and Council dated May 15, 2026, and also provided their recommendations at Council's May 19, 2026, work session; and

WHEREAS, Council approved Resolution No. 20260528-097 directing the City Manager to prepare a potential bond package and necessary ordinances to call a November 2026 bond election; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager is directed to prepare an ordinance for Council consideration to order a November 2026 bond election, including recommended

bond measures, proposition language, categories, and amounts for public
improvements, for the August 6, 2026 Council meeting.
