The Public Health and Housing and Planning Committees jointly recommend to the full council that the City Manager undertake the following work:

- 1. <u>Coordinated Assessment and Wait List Review:</u> Work with the Continuum of Care's Leadership Council, Travis County, service providers, and community organizations to evaluate the coordinated assessment and referral process and make recommendations to improve the wait list for rapid rehousing (RRH) and permanent supportive housing (PSH).
- 2. <u>Improve Pathways to PSH:</u> Explore and provide recommendations with the Leadership Council on the creation of a "Bridge to PSH" program to support individuals eligible for PSH and who currently receive RRH and provide increased flexibility for the Homeless Strategy Office (HSO) to deliver RRH vouchers in the most effective and impactful way for up to 24 months, as necessary.
- 3. <u>Collaborative Long-Term Planning and Investment:</u> Initiate collaboration with Travis County, Central Health and other partner agencies, including the private sector, to establish a forum for the partners to understand the current scope of public sector and philanthropic strategies to address homelessness in our community; discuss the opportunities and challenges of the homelessness response system; and identify opportunities to align strategies, programming, services and/or funding to better address homelessness in our community.
- 3. Discussion and possible action on the status and timeline of amendments to the Land Development Code.
