ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Staff performed an analysis to identify projects from which small amounts of funding could potentially be reallocated without materially affecting delivery of the services originally outlined in the scope of these projects. As a result, staff identified \$920,000 of currently unobligated funding from the Health and Resilience service areas that could be reallocated to the Homelessness service area to support an increase in available funding for the Homelessness Engagement Assistance Response Team (HEART) project.
