# History of Austin Parks Foundation Partnership

### 1992

- Founded by local park advocates to address deteriorating park conditions
- Launched Junior Lifeguard Scholarships (with Sunshine Camps & City)

### 1993

- Created Sponsored Fund Accounts for Adopt-A-Park groups
- Began Colorado River Park & Neighborhood Parks Portfolio programs

### 1996

- Helped form advisory board for Colorado River Park (now Roy G. Guerrero Park)
- Launched 3 Neighborhood Park pilot projects



2003

• Launched It's My Park Day

#### 2006

 Began ACL Music Festival Partnership – annual proceeds benefit Austin parks

#### 2013

• ACL expands to two weekends, increasing support for APF and park improvements
