

**RESOLUTION NO.**

3       **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 20190523-029 directed the City Manager to  
4 prepare for the creation of the Austin Tourism Public Improvement District  
5 (“ATPID”), which would increase hotel activity and tourism in Austin, while also  
6 generating revenue that would make available funding to help address  
7 homelessness, or any other lawful municipal purpose, once the statutory limitations  
8 on use of the funding under Local Government Code, Chapter 372 have been  
9 satisfied; and

10       **WHEREAS**, on September 14, 2023, after working collaboratively with  
11 representatives from the hospitality industry, Council approved a draft service plan  
12 and draft petition language for the creation of the proposed ATPID; and

13       **WHEREAS**, the ATPID service plan includes revenues to the City that may  
14 be dedicated to general fund purposes at the direction of the Council once the  
15 statutory limitations of Local Government Code, Chapter 372 have been met; and

16       **WHEREAS**, Council adopted Resolution No. 20230831-136, directing the  
17 City Manager to establish the House Our People Endowment Fund (“HOPE  
18 Fund”) within the City budget dedicated to receiving and expending funds to  
19 address homelessness; and

20       **WHEREAS**, in a memorandum dated January 25, 2024, the City Manager  
21 confirmed the establishment of the HOPE Fund that allows for the receiving and  
22 expending of funds to address homelessness including the expected use for capital  
23 and operating expenses related to housing and services to supplement the myriad  
24 of City efforts already underway related to homelessness; and

25           **WHEREAS**, the Council seeks to provide clear direction to the City  
26 Manager regarding the use of revenues received from the ATPID as a result of the  
27 City performing services or providing incentives for advertising, promotion, or  
28 business recruitment, directly related to hotels; **NOW, THEREFORE,**

29 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

30           The City Manager is directed to allocate to the HOPE Fund the revenues  
31 that the City receives from the ATPID as a result of the City performing services or  
32 providing incentives for advertising, promotion, or business recruitment, directly  
33 related to hotels.
