Posting Language

Authorize negotiation and execution of an agreement with the Austin LGBT Chamber of Commerce to market Austin to minority and lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) communities; develop and implement a Regional Economic Equity Development Plan; and attract, retain, and expand minority and LGBT business in Austin for a three-year term for a total contract amount not to exceed \$461,250.

Funding in the amount of \$153,750 is available in the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Operating Budget of the Economic Development Department. Funding for future fiscal years is dependent on Council appropriation.

Since March 24, 2022, the Diversity and Ethnic Chamber Alliance (DECA) remains comprised of the Austin LGBT Chamber of Commerce, the Greater Austin Asian Chamber of Commerce, the Greater Austin Black Chamber of Commerce, and the Greater Hispanic Chamber of Commerce. Each of the chambers continue to operate as separate entities under the DECA framework to develop the implementation of the Regional Economic Equity Development Plan and other deliverables as proposed through the negotiation and execution of prior contracts.
