ANALYSIS / ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Pending Council approval of this item, the City will accept \$50,000,000 in grant funds to implement the Phase B project. These grant funds are provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Assistance programs, including their Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) grant, the Texas COVID-19 Pandemic grant (DR4485), and Flood Mitigation Assistance grant. A City funding match of \$65,000,000 is required and is available in the Austin Water, Austin Energy, and Transportation and Public Works Departments' Capital Budgets.

The General Fund will not be required to contribute additional funds beyond those currently budgeted to this grant. When the grant funds expire, the department's need for continuing funding will be evaluated and may be denied.
