Posting Language

Authorize a contract for fuel island parts, repairs and upgrades for Fleet Mobility Services with Excell Environmental dba Excell Fueling Systems, for an initial term of three years with up to two 1-year extension options in an amount not to exceed \$6,080,000. Funding: \$253,333 is available in the Fleet Mobility Service's operating budget. Funding for the remaining contract term is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Funding in the amount of \$253,333 is available in the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 operating budget of Fleet Mobility Services.

The Financial Services Department issued an Invitation for Bid (IFB) 7800 TJP1015 for these goods and services. The solicitation was issued on February 10, 2025, and closed on March 11, 2025. This contract will be awarded in accordance with the City Code Chapter 2-9B (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). For the goods and services required for this solicitation, there were insufficient subcontracting opportunities; therefore, no subcontracting goals were established. Additional Backup Information:

This contract will provide original equipment manufacturer parts and repair services for all City-owned fueling facilities, including aboveground fuel islands and underground storage tanks, and related parts. The contractor will perform diagnostics, cleaning, testing, inspections, and upgrades for the 89 fuel tanks and 44 sites

dispensing various fuels. Repair services will supplement the work performed by Fleet Services personnel. Parts will be purchased for maintenance and repairs handled by Fleet personnel.

This contract will replace a contract which expires on July 29, 2025. The requested authorization amount is based on historical spending and departmental estimates of future needs. The recommended contractor, a certified Texas Historically Underutilized Business, is the current provider for these parts and services.
