

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, City Council was requested to conduct a public hearing in accordance with Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Chapter 26 to consider a resolution authorizing permanent changes in use of dedicated parkland, known as Edward Rendon Sr. Metropolitan Park at Festival Beach, to construct, operate, maintain, and repair an Austin Energy transmission line (Proposed Use); and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Use requires approximately 15,368 square feet of parkland for permanent use; and

WHEREAS, the land being used for the Proposed Use is described in Exhibit A (Affected Land); and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on April 23, 2026, was given for three consecutive weeks on March 29, April 5 and 12, 2026, in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held on April 23, 2026, by City Council to consider the Affected Land for the Proposed Use; **NOW**,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

Having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, City Council finds that there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use and that all reasonable planning has been undertaken

to minimize harm to the Affected Land from the Proposed Use. The use of the Affected Land for the Proposed Use is approved.
