WHEREAS, The Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) administers low-interest loans through the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)'s Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) for a wide range of wastewater, storm water, reuse, and other pollution control projects; and

WHEREAS, the Walnut Creek Wastewater Treatment Plan (WWTP) receives wastewater flow from Austin Water's wastewater collection system and was built in 1977; and

WHEREAS, on May 30, 2024, Council authorized negotiation and execution of a contract for pre-construction and construction services for an expansion of the WWTP to 100 million gallons per day (MGD) and a two-hour peak flow of 3,000 MGD, in accordance with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) regulations and the requirements of Texas Administrative Code Title 30, Part 1; and

WHEREAS, Austin Water is seeking a low-interest loan not to exceed \$59,000,000 from the TWDB to fund a portion of the WWTP expansion project;

WHEREAS, reduced interest rates on this loan will save Austin Water ratepayers financing costs as compared to traditional revenue bond financing; and

WHEREAS, this project will also implement Biological Nutrient Removal in both the existing and proposed facilities to meet more stringent effluent quality limits specified in the WWTP's discharge permit issued by TCEQ; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council authorizes the City Manager or his designee to file an application with the Texas Water Development Board for a low-interest loan from EPA's CWSRF loan program in an amount not to exceed \$59,000,000 to provide for Austin Water's Walnut Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant expansion project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

The City Council designates Shay Ralls Roalson, Director of Austin Water, or her successor, as the authorized representative of the City of Austin for purposes of furnishing such information and executing such documents as may be required in connection with the preparation and filing of such application for financial assistance in compliance and the rules of the TWDB and EPA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

The City Council authorizes the following firms to assist the City in its preparation and submission of the application and if needed, to appear on behalf of and represent the City before any hearing held by the TWDB regarding the application: bond counsel from the firm of McCall, Parkhurst and Horton LLP and financial advisors from the firm of Public Financial Management, Inc.
